

## **Dr. Drew Senyei**



ANDREW (“Drew”) SENYEI, M.D., Managing Director of Enterprise Partners Venture Capital since 1988, has more than 25 years of experience in the building of emerging, life science and healthcare companies.

Dr. Senyei has served on the Boards of more than 30 private and public companies and was named one of the top venture capitalists in the U.S. on Forbes magazine's 2006 Midas Touch List. He is the inventor of the first FDA-approved diagnostic test to predict premature birth, which has been used worldwide by more than 1 million women at risk for preterm birth. He took the invention from conception to a successful start-up and IPO, eventually selling the company to a major corporation.

Dr. Senyei is credited with 30 patents and more than 45 publications in peer-reviewed journals, including the New England Journal of Medicine and Proceedings of the National Academy of Science. He was the recipient of the 2007 Ernst & Young San Diego Entrepreneur Award.

He currently serves on The Board of Trustees at Northwestern University and was formerly the Chair of the UCSD Jacobs School of Engineering Advisory Council, as well as the past president of the San Diego Opera. In 2006 he won a Tony Award as one of the producers of the hit Broadway musical, Jersey Boys.

Dr. Senyei received his M.D. from Northwestern University and completed his residency training in Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of California, Irvine, where he served on the faculty prior to becoming active full-time with venture capital funding of early stage medical companies.
