The “Marie Curie Actions” have long been one of the most popular and appreciated features of the Community Framework Programs for Research and Technological Development. They have developed significantly in orientation over time, from a pure mobility fellowships program to a program dedicated to stimulating researchers' career development. The “Marie Curie Actions” have been particularly successful in responding to the needs of Europe's scientific community in terms of training, mobility and career development. This has been demonstrated by a demand in terms of highly ranked applications that in most actions extensively surpassed the available financial support.

In the Seventh Framework Program, the “Marie Curie Actions” have been regrouped and reinforced in the “People” Specific Program. Entirely dedicated to human resources in research, this Specific Program has a significant overall budget of more than € 4,7 billion over a seven year period until 2013.

The “People” Specific Program will be implemented through actions under five headings, with the following indicative budget breakdown:

Activities	Indicative budget share 2007-2013
1. Initial Training of Researchers	around 40 %
2. Life-long Training and Career Development (including Co-funding)	between 25% and 30%
3. Industry-Academia Pathways and Partnerships	5 to 10%
4. International Dimension – World Fellowships	25 to 30%
5. Specific Policy Actions	around 1%

Marie Curie Initial Training Networks (ITN) under *Initial training* aims to improve early-stage researchers' career prospects in both the public and private sectors, thereby making research careers more attractive to young people. This will be achieved through a transnational networking mechanism, aimed at structuring the existing high-quality initial research training capacity throughout Member States and Associated Countries.

The action will be implemented by supporting competitively selected networks of organizations from different countries engaged in research training. The networks will be built on a joint research training program, responding to well identified training needs in defined scientific areas, with appropriate reference to interdisciplinary and newly emerging supra-disciplinary fields.

Support will be provided for:

- Recruitment of researchers (who are still within the first five years of their careers in research) for initial training.
- Recruitment of Senior Visiting Scientists of outstanding stature in international training and collaborative research to strengthen transfer of knowledge.
- Networking activities, organization of workshops and conferences, involving the participants own research staff and external researchers.

Training will be primarily focused on scientific and technological knowledge through research on individual, personalized projects, complemented by substantial training modules addressing other relevant skills and competences. Examples include research in the field of management and financing of research projects and programs, intellectual property rights and other exploitation methods of research results, entrepreneurship, ethical aspects, communication and societal outreach.

The action will be primarily for the recruitment of researchers from Member States and associated countries, but also open to researchers from third countries. Researchers are normally required to undertake transnational mobility (i.e. move from one country to another) when taking up appointment.

Normally a network will be composed of at least three participants (multi-partner networks), but mono-partner networks are also possible under certain conditions. There is no budgetary limit in ITN; however, since the budget is based on the number of researcher-months requested. The usual duration of funding for ITN is 48 months from the start date of the grant agreement.

The deadline for proposals is 26 January 2011 and the indicative overall budget is EUR 318.41 million.

## 1.1. Marie Curie ITN Success Stories

### FENS Faculty Member Dr. Emrah Kalemci describes his ITN Project

During my PhD in the United States I started collaborating with the young generation of black hole physicists across the Western Europe. After I returned to Turkey to SU, the channels for collaboration increased with the ease of travel across Europe, and through availability of EU funding. Late 2006 we started discussing about more organized collaboration and had a meeting in Amsterdam. The consensus was that there were not enough young researchers/graduate students (or experienced researchers and early stage researchers in the FP7 jargon) in the field that will tackle the challenge of analyzing fresh data that will arrive with the new radio and X-ray observatories. There was also lack of realistic models of multi-wavelength emission from jets in black hole binary systems. We decided to write a proposal for an Initial Training Network, as the action aims to improve early stage researchers' career prospects by making research career quite attractive through high salaries and private research funding. The leadership of the project was taken by Prof. Joern Wilms of Friedrich-Alexander-Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg.

The network aims to reveal many of the hidden aspects of black holes and their impact on the universe. Our main scientific focus is on X-ray binary systems which contain the black hole remnant of a massive star orbiting a normal stellar companion and feeding from it through a process called 'accretion'. These systems are laboratories for studying accretion and its effects, including powerful X-ray radiation from the superheated gas falling on to the black hole, rapid variability and emission signatures of strong gravity originating in the extreme conditions close to the black hole, and the production of powerful relativistic jets of plasma which can affect the surrounding environment.

When writing the proposal we emphasized three aspects of the network. First, seven members of the network are leading institutes in black hole science in Europe with respect to both research and training of young researchers. Second, we stressed the importance of realistic, physical models of jet emission and accretion that was not present at the time, bringing out the innovative part of the project. And finally, we came up with a "super-mobility" scheme, pairing each early stage researcher with a partner institute for short term visits. The proposal also included two collaboration meetings, two summer schools and two scientific conferences. On top of these, we were careful to include references from the Third European Report on Science & Technology Indicators, Green and White Papers on space policy in Europe, EC's Communication on the European Space Policy, Erasmus Program, European Space Agency and NASA Road Maps and more.

Early 2008 the proposal nicknamed "Black Hole Universe" got accepted and negotiations started, and the project officially started in October 2008 with a total budget of 2.5 Million Euros. SU leads one of the PhD projects, "Multiwavelength Observations of Galactic Black Hole Transients" and hired one early stage researcher, Mr. Yoon-Young Chun from Korea. SU will also hold one of the Collaboration Meetings in September 2010.

Throughout the proposal writing phases (ITN Call had two rounds of proposals), and during negotiations I got strong help from the RGP. RGP personnel read the entire proposal, including the science part, and their comments improved the proposal. Since this was the first FP7 ITN project Turkey has won as a partner, I was invited to TUBITAK FP7 Mobility Summit to present our successful proposal writing experience.
